Features

- 1. Seamless installation of aftermarket head unit using plug and play No splicing of factory wires.
- Compatible with all the major aftermarket navigation/stereo manufacturers.
- 3. Retains the functions of your factory navigation, turn by turn direction voice, other OEM electronics such as the OEM climate controls and Mark Levinson Sound System.
- 4. The OEM door to house CD player/headunit will remain functional.
- 5. Ability to control volume, fader and video input source to OEM screen using steering wheel controls. 6. Video input interfacing to the OEM factory navgiation screen.

Caution

- 1. By installing a new aftermarket head unit, the OEM CD changer will have to be removed and will no longer be functional.
- 2. Before performing installation and removing OEM head unit, confirm that the fader, balance, bass and treble levels are at the center or "0" on the OEM head unit.
- 3. About the navigation turn by turn voice used with MVA-13L:
- -The OEM System will mute the music from the aftermarket head unit to give turn by turn voice during the use of OEM navigation system
- -The navigation's turn by turn voice sound volume can be adjusted using the MENU option on the navigation screen.
- 4. Any alterations to the OEM navigation, OEM amplifier or the OEM electronic system may prevent MVA-13L to operate correctly.
- 5. The steering wheel control feature does not control your new headunit, but controls your OEM amplifier. Volume is controlled by changing amplifier gain and fader is controlled on the amplifier. For more information, please read "Appendix A, Operation Manual".



Precautions before installation

1. Remove the negative terminal from the battery.

2. In order to protect the interior of the vehicle, cover the interior parts around the work areas with protective tape or cloth.

3. After installation, confirm that brake lamp, headlight, turn signals, wiper blades and other vehicle functions are operating properly.

Before installing the new head unit or navigation, confirm that the OEM audio and navigation is functioning properly without any complications or issues.

1. Remove the climate control panel.


4. Remove the OEM Head Unit
